

# Campsite Information and Schedule of Fees

## General Information:

The Piedmont Hunt Club owns and operates two hunt camps; one is located in Fairfield County and the other in Kershaw County. Both sites have county water, covered shelters & skinning facilities, and year round camping. The Fairfield camp has sight-in ranges for both archery & firearms and the youth enjoy pitching horseshoes and riding their ATVs on the ATV riding course. For a small annual fee, members can rent campsites and leave their campers on site year round. This fee is dependent upon operating costs of the camp. The Fairfield Hunt Camp is the larger camp and is located just a few miles from a public boat ramp accessing Lake Wateree. This lake offers some of the best crappie fishing in the spring and also sports good large mouth and stripped bass fishing throughout the year. The Kershaw Hunt Camp is smaller and is located within a short drive of the Carolina Sandhills National Wildlife Refuge and the Sandhill State Forest.

## Directions:

The **Fairfield Hunt Camp** is located approximately a one hour drive south from Charlotte, NC and 1/2 hour drive north of Columbia, SC. Via I-77 take exit 48 east onto SC Hwy 200 for 2.8 miles to crossroads at Mitford, take a right on SSR 55, go 1.1 miles to intersection and bear right staying on SSR 55, go 1.1 miles to junction US Hwy 21 (Stop sign with red flashing light) continue across intersection staying on SSR 55, go about 300 yards, turn right at club sign (Camp is located just behind Fairfield County Recycle Facility).

The **Kershaw Hunt Camp** is located in the Sand Hill area, approximately a 1 1/2 hour drive from Charlotte, NC and Columbia, SC. Several different routes can be taken. Directions from Charlotte: Take SC Hwy 521 to Lancaster, SC, take bypass loop off SC Hwy 521 at first overpass (Signs will say SC Hwy 9 & SC Hwy 903 to the beach), go to SC Hwy 903 exit and head east, go approximately 20 miles, take right (south) onto SC Hwy 346, go approximately 6 miles to a right hand curve with a pond on the right, just past pond, take right onto Mill Acres Road, go straight about .3 miles to the hunt camp.
