The **Piedmont Hunt Club** is primarily a big game hunt club pursuing the **White-Tailed Deer** and **Wild Turkey**. In coming up with a proper patch design it seemed only fitting to create a logo with that in mind and to include something which represents each individuals goal in promoting good hunting ethics and conduct. The subdued colors of the patch should blend in with any of the camouflage clothing that you may be wearing afield. The following represents the background for the components of the **Patch/Logo**:

1) **Piedmont** means "lying or formed at the base of mountains" therefore our club, being situated . in the rolling hills of the piedmont region between the flat coastal plains and the more rugged mountains is appropriately named.

2) The silhouette of the **White-Tailed Buck** on a **brown background** represents the **fall hunting** of this magnificent animal.

3) The silhouette of the **Wild Turkey Gobbler** on the **green background** represents the **spring hunting** of this wary and elusive creature.

4) The word **RESPECT** is an acronym which stands for" **Responsible Educated Sportsmen Promoting Ethical Conduct Together**". Five principles of ethical conduct are:

- **RESPECT for nature**
- **RESPECT for the game animal**
- **RESPECT for the landowner**
- **RESPECT for fellow sportsmen**
