

# Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What are Piedmont Hunt Club's dues?

A: \$1,450.00

Q: How much land does Piedmont Hunt Club have?

A: Over 10,000 acres

Q: How many members does Piedmont Hunt Club have every year?

A: Piedmont Hunt Club caps their membership at 90 members. After 90 members are attained, your name goes on a waiting list.

Q: What is Piedmont Hunt Club's acres per member?

A: Presently Piedmont Hunt Club is at 111 acres per member

Q: Does Piedmont Hunt Club Practice QDM?

A: Yes. Bucks have to meet a requirement of a 15" outside spread. Piedmont Hunt Club also allows anyone who has never shot an antlered buck to shoot one (1) of their choice, and youths age 17 and under get one buck of their choice per season.

Q: Does the Piedmont Hunt Club have Club Stands?

A: Yes - ground blinds, towers stands, one man tripods, one man ladder stands and two man ladder stands

Q: Does the Piedmont Hunt Club have Food Plots?

A: Yes – a year round food plot program

Q: Does the Piedmont Hunt Club offer camp sites? If so what are the rates?

A: Yes. Tent camping is free. A member can attain a camp site for additional fees: Annual Camp Site fee of \$250.00. There is a one time water hook up fee of \$100.00 and a one time electric hook up fee of \$375.00. There will be a monthly electric bill which will fluctuate depending on your usage.

Q: Besides deer, what other game does Piedmont Hunt Club have on their lands?

A: Turkey, Hogs, Rabbits, ducks and Squirrels.

Q: Does Piedmont Hunt Club offer any other types of memberships, like a "turkey membership" or a "duck membership" for example?

A: No

Q: If I join who can I bring to hunt with me?

A: Children, brothers and sisters, and guests who are age **EIGHTEEN (18)** or younger; full time students; spouse, mother and father shall be **ASSOCIATE MEMBERS** and will be covered by the **MEMBER'S** dues.
